## Easter Cards 2013

Scallop Oval Easel Egg Card
Chocolate Bunny (retired) \& Teeny Tiny Wishes stamp sets; Whisper White, Crumb Cake, Chocolate Chip, Certainly Celery, Pool Party \& Daffodil Delight CS; Subtles Collection DSP; Little Leaves Sizzlet; Trio Flowers (retired), Boho Blossoms, Dotted Scallop Ribbon Border, Word Window \& Modern Label punches; Ovals Collection framelits; Vintage Wallpaper embossing folder; Daffodil Delight seam binding ribbon; selfadhesive rhinestones; Occasions piercing pack.
Create card base by laying scallop oval over a top-fold edge by $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, then cut one extra scallop oval, all from Whisper White. Score top layer of card base at $23 / 4 \prime \prime$ horizontally across the oval. Glue extra oval BELOW score line only, and crease fold line down, to create the easel effect. Go ahead and paper pierce top layers of card now, if desired. You'll be piercing thru 2 layers on lower portion of card front.
Adhere foil to White CS using runner, and cut out next size down oval. Cut center out using oval \#3, then emboss foiled oval "ring."
Cut Certainly Celery DSP using Oval \#5, and adhere flat to card front. Pop dot foiled oval window over DSP layer.
Stamp Chocolate Bunny and sentiment in Chocolate Chip craft ink onto Crumb Cake CS and clear emboss. Stamp off bunny onto envelope lower right front and set aside to let dry. Cut out bunny and punch sentiment with Word Window punch. Slip bunny behind foil frame as desired and glue in place. Layer sentiment onto Chocolate Chip Modern Label layer.
Tie ribbon around frame and make a bow. Decorate frame with Little Leaves in Certainly Celery, and flowers from other punches as shown - embellish flowers with rhinestones.
For inside card, layer a strip of Dotted Scallop Ribbon in Daffodil Delight over a $3 / 4$ " strip of Pool Party. Glue assembled strip across card as shown and trim ends carefully. Sample shows two rows, you should only have one. Make sure easel stands up to height you want BEFORE gluing down strip! Pop dot sentiment along center of strip to serve a s a stop for the card front.

## Ears To You Card Inspired by Linda Callahan

Ears To You stamp; Calypso Coral \& Whisper White CS; Sent With Love DSP; Calypso Coral organdy ribbon (retired); Elegant Bouquet embossing folder; Festive piercing pack; Wisteria Wonder, Calypso Coral \& Lucky Limeade markers; Labels Collection framelits; Large Scallop edgelit; selfadhesive pearl.
Landscape top-fold card base in Calypso Coral. White layer at $51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \prime$.
Cut $51^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of coordinating DSP, and scallop one long edge of each strip, aligning carefully, using edgelit. Use bone folder to add just a bit of curl up to the scallops.
Emboss white layer if desired, and color flower petals in a circular motion with Calypso Coral ink and a water marker, if desired. Glue down scalloped strips as shown, one at a time, aligning scallops. Trim ends when done (that's why the strips were a little long - to give you some wiggle room.) Tie ribbon around scallops as shown, pulling bow to left side.
 Using markers, ink up stamp as shown, and stamp on Whisper White. Cut out with Label framelit. If desired, stamp extra Calypso Coral bunny onto white scrap, and cut out. Pop dot over base stamped image and add pearl at tail. Glue stamped image onto next size up Label in Calypso Coral, pierce that layer all around if desired. Pop dot assembled image over scallops and ribbon, sliding bow to the left as needed to make room. Glue down all onto card base.


Everybunny Tri-Shutter Card
CASE'd from Connie Plaumann
Everybunny stamp set; Old Olive, Daffodil Delight \& Whisper White CS; Sunshine \& Sprinkles DSP; Old Olive $1 / 4$ " grosgrain; Little Leaves \& Floral Fusion sizzlets; Jumbo self-adhesive Pearl.
For card base, cut CS at $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$. On long edge, score at $2^{\prime \prime}, 4^{\prime \prime}, 8^{\prime \prime}$ and $10^{\prime \prime}$.
Turn a $1 / 4$ turn, and $11 / 2 \prime$ from both long edges, cut slit between the $2^{\prime \prime}$ and $10^{\prime \prime}$ score lines (cutting through the two center score lines as well.)
Tri-fold as shown by sample, when done, card will lay flat and fit in a standard envelope.
Adhere DSP pieces as shown. I have pre-cut them for you, but the sizes are:
2 - $17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ 3/8"; 4 - $17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 13 / 8^{\prime \prime} ; 2$ - $17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ $1 / 4^{\prime \prime} ; 2$ - $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 13 / 8^{\prime \prime} ; 1-37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
All images are stamped in Black Staz-On. Stamp 2
flower pots onto $1^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Whisper White. Stamp chick onto $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 13 /{ }^{\prime \prime \prime}$ piece, and also envelope front. Stamp egg bunny and sentiment (assembled onto 1 block for you) onto $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece, and balloon bunny onto scrap. Watercolor all images carefully, using various inks that match the DSP. Cut out balloon bunny and pop dot to front as shown; adhere rest of images as shown. Tie ribbon piece around lower center flap as shown, and assemble floral embellishment and adhere to upper center, also as shown.
(To make from $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ : Cut base at $5 \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$; score at $1 \frac{1}{4}, 3 \frac{1}{2}, 7$ and $8 \frac{3}{4}$. Cut slits at $1 \frac{1}{2}$ and $31 / 2$. Finished size $5 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$.)

Daisy Easter
Well Scripted (retired) \& Best of Flowers stamp sets; Daffodil Delight, Lucky Limeade \& Whisper White CS; Floral District DSP; Daisy \#2 \& Top Note dies; Key Tag (retired); Decorative Label \& Scallop Trim Border punches; $1 /{ }^{\prime \prime \prime}$ stitched grosgrain in Daffodil Delight; buttons in Daffodil Delight; Vine Street embossing folder.
Standard landscape top-fold card base in Daffodil Delight. Border punch lower front edge, and adhere DSP strip inside card to show through the punched border.
Cut two Top Notes, one in Lucky Limeade and one in White.
Emboss white one, and trim off edge to layer over Lucky Limeade one. Wrap ribbon as shown, and adhere all to card base.
Assemble daisy - there are three of each size daisy to layer.
Curl largest daisy petals UNDER a bit, and the other two
sizes UP. Glue layers one at a time, off-setting each daisy for fullness. Glue down assembled daisy as shown. Thread and knot yellow cotton through larger button, and glue dot to flower center.
Stamp sentiment in Daffodil Delight onto white scrap and punch; layer onto Lucky Limeade Decorative Label. Add flower button as shown and adhere pearl to button. Pop dot sentiment as shown.
Stamp all along envelope flap with flower image in Daffodil Delight.
