Paper Bows Tutorial Heather Heroldt

Ingredients:

9–1" strips of paper, one color, or mixed patterns to these lengths: 3-11", 3-10", 2-9", and $1-3\frac{1}{2}$ ".

- 1. Fold all the strips in half except for the shortest one, to give you a center point on each strip.
- 2. Put adhesive on both ends of the pattern side of each strip.
- 3. Twist each end of the strip around in a point and secure adhesive to center fold mark. (Pics 1, 2 & 3)
- 4. Curl short strip into a circle, and secure end with adhesive. (Pic 3)
- 5. Punch small hole into center of each loop, and at the bottom of the circle loop. (Pic 4)
- 6. Place adhesive on top of each loop, close to hole. Assemble like sizes with adhesive, lining up holes. This should give you three "layers," plus the top little circle. (Pic 5)
- 7. Starting from "top," that is, the circle, assemble layers with brad through holes. Press open brad at bottom layer on the table. (Pic 6 & 7)
- 8. Without peeling off wax paper, press glue dot to bottom over the brad legs, so you can stick it to a gift! (Pic 7)
